#### **National Service Scheme**

National Service Scheme, under the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports Govt. of India, popularly known as NSS was launched in Gandhiji's Birth Centenary Year 1969, in 37 Universities involving 40,000 students with primary focus on the development of personality of students through community service. NSS department of the college has been a vibrant and active unit. It has been rendering various services to the society. At present, college has 5 NSS units with 500 volunteers. The overall objective of this scheme is educational and services to community. It is student centred program in which projects are implemented by NSS volunteers.

NSS department organizes various 1-day & 7-days camps every year in which cleanness drives, blood donation camps, various awareness lectures and rallies on social evils are conducted.

The main objectives of National Service Scheme (NSS) are:

#### 1. Registration of NSS Volunteers for the Session 2022-23.




Figure 9: Brochure of Guest lecture on Blood Donation.
