


Understanding of the course content (N=1270) % age


Expectation of the course relevance to the outcome (N=1270) % age


Learning value (in terms of knowledge, concepts, abilities) of thecourse (N=1270) % age


Relevance of the course in terms of the job (N=1270) % age


Relevance of the course in terms of skill & employability (N=1270) % age


Relevance of the course to your real life (N=1270) % age


Relevance of the laboratory works / project work to your future life(N=1270) % age


Extent of the curriculum in creation of interest towards higher studies(N=1270) % age


Academic/ extension activity helpful in enhancement of your personality(N=1270) % age


Rate overall learning experience of the program (N=1270) % age
