## MOU's signed by the College for Solid, Liquid and E Waste Management E-Waste Management MOU

This AGREEMENT is entered at Chandigarh on 11<sup>th</sup> Day of the month of May 2023

Between

M/s. ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION having its registered office address at Plot No 67-B, Lodhi Majra Industrial Area, Baddi, Tehsil Nalagarh (H.P). Herein referred to as Recycler.

And

M/s. Guru Nanak College having its registered and collection address at Guru Nanak College Budhlada, Tehsil Budhlada, Distt Mansa, Punjab 151503. Herein referred to as Generator.

AND WHEREAS, the foremost and the sole objective of M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION is to prevent Environmental Pollution Hazards and to observe the existing laws on Environmental Pollution Control.

AND WHEREAS, the GENERATOR desires to send its E-Waste (hereinafter referred to as 'HAZARDOUS WASTE') to M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION as per the norms of Himachal Pradesh State Pollution Control Board (hereinafter referred to as "HSPSCB") and M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION having requisite facilities in this behalf, agrees to receive the E-Waste sent by the GENERATOR on the terms and conditions stated hereunder, which have been mutually agreed to by and between M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION and the MEMBER.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT witnesses as follows:

### SCOPE OF THE AGREEMENT

M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION shall collect, transport, and dispose the E-Waste collected from the premises of the Generator. It shall be the responsibility of M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION to demagnetize the hard disks before disposing them off in accordance with the terms of the contract. If the hard disks come along with the CPU the activity would be taken care by M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION at free of cost.

"OIC" is here in after referred as ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION

Upon intimation from the Generator, OIC shall within 7 days there from, arrange for collection of E-Waste as per the applicable provisions. The Generator shall issue delivery challan/bill before collection of the E-Waste from the designated place by "OIC".

The E-Waste collected shall be weighed by the Parties at the nearest weighment center available as identified by the Parties. The weighment of the E-Waste shall be done in the presence of the representatives of both the Parties and both the Parties shall acknowledge such weighment slip generated. In case of any discrepancy in the weighment as per delivery challan and the weighment slip, the details as per weighment slip shall be considered for payment by "OIC".

The Generator liability shall cease once the E-Waste has been collected by "OIC" from its premises except for any non-disclosure of any material information known to the Generator with regard to E-Waste from "OIC" during the handover of such E- Waste. It is specifically agreed and understood that compliances of applicable law.

During transportation and disposal of E-Waste shall be exclusive responsibility of the "OIC".

"OIC" shall, issue a safe destruction certificate as prescribed under applicable laws within forty-five (45) days from receipt of such request.

### PAYMENTS

M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION shall pay the amount on the basis of lot as proposed by Guru Nanak College Budhlada, on time to time basis, before the pickup of the material as per the E-Waste Rules 2022-23 setup by the Ministry of Environment and Forests and Central Pollution Control Board, Government of India

#### MISCELLANEOUS


1. The confidentiality obligation under this Agreement shall exist during the term of this Agreement and for a period of three (3) years from the expiry of this Agreement.
3. Notice: Any notice or other communication under or in connection with this agreement shall be in writing in the English language and shall be delivered personally or delivered to the party due to receive the notice or communication at its address set out below or such other address as either party may specify by notice in writing to other from time to time.
4. Amendment & Modification: Amendments and modifications to this Agreement shall be valid only if made in writing and signed by the Parties.
5. No Representation: Nothing in this Agreement shall authorize any Party to engage in transactions in the name of the other Party or in any activities, which may create a liability on such other Party.
6. No Assignment: Parties shall not assign or transfer this Agreement or any Order or any parts of its rights and obligations hereunder to any person or corporation without the prior written consent of the other Party.
7. No Waiver: No failure to exercise, nor any delay in exercising, on the part of either Party, any right or remedy hereunder shall operate as a waiver thereof, nor shall any single or partial exercise of any right or remedy prevent any further or other exercise thereof or the exercise of any other right or remedy.

9. Entire Agreement: This Agreement and the Order(s) constitute the entire agreement between the Parties.
10. Duplicate Agreements: This Agreement has been signed in two counterparts, each of which shall be deemed as an original but both of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.



M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION may withhold any payment in case of any dispute regarding the weightment of E-Waste and any such withholding of payment shall under this clause shall not be considered as a material breach of this Agreement.

#### TERM AND TERMINATION

This Agreement shall be in force for a period of One year from the date of signing of this Agreement. Upon completion of the term, the Agreement may be renewed at the option of both the Parties in writing on mutually agreed terms and conditions.

The Agreement may be terminated by either party without assigning any reason, by giving Thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other Party.

#### COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS

- i. It shall exercise all safety precaution and best management practices, required by law, in providing service under this Agreement;
- ii. It shall notify the Generator immediately if any permit, licenses, certificate, consent approval or identification number required for the performance of its service under this Agreement has been revoked, modified, expired, suspended or not been renewed;
- iii. M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION shall comply with all applicable laws, rules and regulations and shall indemnify and hold the Generator harmless in this regard.

Subject to the arbitration provisions herein, courts of competent jurisdiction in Himachal Pradesh shall have the exclusive jurisdiction on the matters arising out of or in connection with this Agreement. No Party shall be restrained from approaching the court for seeking interim relief under this Agreement.
